## **MANDATORY CONSERVE WATER**

July 6, 2023

Due to the water main break and resulting loss of water, a mandatory conserve water has been issued. In order to comfortably deal with this situation for an extended amount of time the water district has issued these rules which if not complied with, may be enforced by your being water shut off, a fine being applied to your bill, or both. This order will be in effect until our water tanks are brought to full capacity. It is imperative that our tanks are full in the event of a fire this season. Our goal is that this will only be in effect for this month, but we need the water users to follow this conserve water order.

The mandatory rules are as follows:

- ✓ Residents whose address ends with an even number may **ONLY** outdoor water on Tuesdays and Fridays (Example: 380 Circle Oaks Dr).
- ✓ Residents whose address ends with an odd number may **ONLY** outdoor water on Mondays and Thursdays (Example: 381 Circle Oaks Dr).
- ✓ Outdoor watering\* may take no longer than 10 minutes of combined watering. This includes any outdoor cleaning or individual plants being watered.
- ✓ No use of hoses without a flow regulating nozzle/sprayer may be used.
- ✓ No filling of pools or hot tubs/spas.
- ✓ Residents are responsible for maintaining their outdoor watering systems to ensure there are no wasteful breaks.
- ✓ Any outdoor cleaning must utilize a water miser device like a pressure washer.

\* "Outdoor watering" refers to ANY use of water outdoors for any reason.
