**ORDINANCE No. 07-1**

**AN ORDINANCE LIFTING THE CONNECTION  
RESTRICTION IMPOSED BY ORDINANCE NO. 06-1  
and OPENING THE DISTRICT FOR SERVICE  
CONNECTIONS**

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, in District Ordinance No. 06-1 the Board of Directors of the Circle Oaks County Water District lifted a moratorium on new water connections for undeveloped Circle Oaks lots first imposed in September 2000 by District Ordinance No. 00-1; and

**WHEREAS**, in District Ordinance No. 06-1 the District imposed restrictions based on the "Cleanup and Abatement Order" levied by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (CVRWQCB) on the Circle Oaks wastewater system; and

**WHEREAS**, based on direct contacts with the CVRWQCB, no restrictions on hookups have been imposed by the CVRWQCB and the District is on schedule in fully complying with the terms and conditions imposed by the Order; and

**WHEREAS**, although all conditions whose correction is required by the Order have not been corrected, corrections are underway and the Board has determined that restrictions on hookups can now be terminated without impairing or creating a risk of impairment of surface or ground waters;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
OF THE CIRCLE OAKS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The District Board hereby finds the foregoing Recitals to be true and correct.
2. After considerable study and analysis, the District Board finds and determines that the connection restriction that was imposed by District Ordinance No. 06-1 on 21 December 2006 is no longer necessary because all required milestones imposed by the Order have been completed or are underway. The Circle Oaks wastewater system has been determined to be able at this time to safely accommodate additional connections.
3. Based upon the findings above, the District Board hereby terminates the wastewater service connection restriction that was imposed by District Ordinance No. 06-1 on 21 December 2006.
4. Commencing upon adoption of final hookup procedures and a new hookup fee, the District may accept new applications for water and wastewater connections.
5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption, but within 10 days of adoption shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the District, and shall be posted on no less than 3 public bulletin boards within the District.
6. The District Board finds and determines that the adoption of this Ordinance and the activities authorized by this Ordinance are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Control Act under the "general rule" based on the fact that under the foregoing finding it can be seen with certainty that the action approved will not itself have an adverse effect on the environment. This general rule determination is made pursuant to Circle Oaks Resolution 06-4, the Circle Oaks local procedures for implementing CEQA State guidelines.
